

The Nottinghamshire County (Boughton Road, Marjorie Street, Mary Street, Royds Crescent, Steetley Lane and Tylden Road, Rhodesia) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (1266)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads in Rhodesia in the District of Bassetlaw: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

BOUGHTON ROAD, RHODESIA (south east side)

• From its junction with Tylden Road in a north-easterly direction for 10 metres.

BOUGHTON ROAD, RHODESIA (north west side)

• From its junction with Steetley Lane in a north easterly direction for 10 metres.

MARJORIE STREET, RHODESIA (both sides)

• From its junction with Tylden Road in a southerly direction for 10 metres.

MARY STREET, RHODESIA (both sides)

• From its junction with Tylden Road in a southerly direction for 10 metres.

ROYDS CRESCENT, RHODESIA (both sides)

• From its junction with Tylden Road in a north westerly direction for 10 metres.

STEETLEY LANE, RHODESIA (north east side)

• From its junction with Boughton Road in a north westerly direction for 10 metres

TYLDEN ROAD, RHODESIA (north side)

- From its junction with Boughton Road in a north easterly direction for 10 metres
- From a point 10 metres south west of its junction with Royds Crescent in a north easterly direction to a point 10 metres north east of that junction.

TYLDEN ROAD, RHODESIA (south east side)

- From a point 10 metres south west of its junction with Marjorie Street in a north easterly direction to a point 10 metres north east of that junction.
- From a point 10 metres south west of its junction with Mary Street in a north easterly direction to a point 10 metres north east of that junction.
