

<u>The Nottinghamshire County (Common Lane and Thornhill Road, Harworth)</u> (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (1269)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads in Harworth in the District of Bassetlaw -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

<u>COMMON LANE, HARWORTH</u> (north east side)

• From a point 37 metres north-west of its junction with the Common Lane cul-de-sac serving the properties 6 to 24 to its junction with Thornhill Road.

THORNHILL ROAD, HARWORTH (north east side)

• From its junction with Common Lane in a north-westerly and then a north-easterly direction to a point 20 metres south west of a point opposite the south-western kerb line of Bracken Way.
