

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Atkin Lane and High Oakham Drive, Mansfield)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (2221)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council, with permission from the Street Manager of High Oakham Drive, proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Mansfield in the District of Mansfield:-

Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along the following lengths of road:

ATKIN LANE, MANSFIELD (the north side)

- from a point opposite a point 18 metres west of its junction with High Oakham Drive in an easterly direction for 60 metres

ATKIN LANE, MANSFIELD (the south side)

- from a point 18 metres west of its junction with High Oakham Drive in an easterly direction for 60 metres

HIGH OAKHAM DRIVE, MANSFIELD (the south-east side)

- from its junction with Atkin Lane in a south-westerly direction for 22 metres

HIGH OAKHAM DRIVE, MANSFIELD (the north-west side)

- from its junction with Atkin Lane in a south-westerly direction for 19 metres
