

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Blyth in the District of Bassetlaw:-

**Length of Road shall become a 40mph speed limit**

- Bawtry Road, Blyth  
From a point 254m north its junction with The Woodlands in a north easterly direction to a point 529m southwest of its junction with Snape Lane (approximately 606m).

It is proposed to change the existing derestricted speed limit to 40mph on the above road, north of Blyth. The proposed 40mph speed limit will fulfil planning conditions associated with the new development to the west of Bawtry Road and facilitate the safe operation of a new junction and the wider Highway.
