

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Coniston Road, Kendal
Close and Keswick Road Worksop)
(20mph Speed Limit) Order 2022 (1267)**

The Council of the County of Nottinghamshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on that length of road in Worksop in the District of Bassetlaw as specified in the Schedule of this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Coniston Road, Kendal Close and Keswick Road Worksop) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2022 (1267)" and shall come into force on the ## day of ## 2020.

SCHEDULE

Length of Road at Worksop in the District of Bassetlaw

Coniston Road,

From its southeast junction with Keswick Road in a westerly and then northerly direction to its northwest junction with Keswick Road.

Kendal Close

From its junction with Keswick Road in a northerly and then westerly direction to its western extremity.

Keswick Road

From its junction with Carlton Road in a westerly and then north westerly direction to its north westerly extremity.
