**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (COXMOOR ROAD,
SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD) (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018 (4228)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Sutton-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified below:-

Coxmoor Road (Sutton-in-Ashfield)

- (i) From a point 505 metres south-east of its junction with Cauldwell Road in a south-easterly direction for 1040 metres
2. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act in so far as it relates to the lengths of road specified above is hereby revoked.
