THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DERBY ROAD (A611),
KIRKBY-IN-ASHFIELD) (50 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018 (4218)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Kirkby-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on that length of road specified below

A611 Derby Road, Kirkby-in-Ashfield

- (i) from a point 167 metres north-east of its junction with Shoulder of Mutton Hill (B6021) in a north easterly direction to a point 101 metres south-west of its junction with Blidworth Road (B6020)
- (ii) from a point 87 metres north-east of its junction with Blidworth Road (B6020) in a north-easterly direction to a point 63 metres south-west of its junction with Cauldwell Road.
