

## The Nottinghamshire County Council Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

## THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GORSETHOPE LANE, KINGS CLIPSTONE) (50 M.P.H. AND 30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018 (3283)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Kings Clipstone in the District of Newark and Sherwood:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on that length of road specified below

Gorsethorpe Lane, Kings Clipstone

- (i) from a point 80 metres north-west of its junction with Squires Lane in a north-westerly direction to its junction with A6075 Mansfield Road.
- 2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on that length of road specified below

Gorsethorpe Lane, Kings Clipstone

(i) From its junction with Main Road in a westerly and then north-westerly direction to a point 80 metres north-west of its junction with Squires Lane.
