

## The Nottinghamshire County Council (Kirkby Road and Sherwood Road, Sutton-in-Ashfield) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (4227)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Sutton-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield:-

Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along the following lengths of road: -

- 1. KIRKBY ROAD, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD (the east side)
  - from a point 6 metres south of its junction with Sherwood Road in a northerly direction to a point 50 metres north of that junction
- 2. SHERWOOD ROAD, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD (both sides)
  - from its junction with Kirkby Road in a north-easterly direction for 8 metres
