

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LANTERN LANE, SHARPLEY DRIVE, EAST LEAKE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) (NO STOPPING ON ENTRANCE CLEARWAYS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (TRO 8385) AND PROVISION OF HUMPED ZEBRA CROSSING ON LANTERN LANE, EAST LEAKE

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Via East Midlands Ltd is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire.

Nottinghamshire County Council is proposing to extend the existing traffic calming to install a zebra crossing to assist pedestrians in crossing Lantern Lane to access both the primary and secondary schools and leisure centres.

As part of these proposals the Single Yellow Lines and School Keep Clear Marking road markings which Prohibit Stopping Mon – Fri 8 am – 4.30 pm in the area outside all of the schools and the Leisure Centre are being revised to make it easier and safer for pedestrians to access the school and Leisure Centre. This parking restriction is also required to help improve conditions for buses accessing/egressing the school site.

The proposal also includes providing junction protection to improve access and visibility for drivers when entering and exiting the junction of Sharpley Drive and Lantern Lane.
