

**The Nottinghamshire County Council**  
**(Lawns Road and Skegby Road, Kirkby-in-Ashfield)**  
**(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (4222)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Kirkby-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield:-

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting at any time** along the following lengths of road: -

LAWNS ROAD, KIRKBY-IN-ASHFIELD (north-west side)

- from its junction with Skegby Road in a north-easterly direction for 21 metres

LAWNS ROAD, KIRKBY-IN-ASHFIELD (south-east side)

- from its junction with Skegby Road in a north-easterly direction for 27 metres

SKEGBY ROAD, KIRKBY-IN-ASHFIELD (the north-east side)

- from a point 15 metres north-west of its junction with Lawns Road in a south-easterly direction to a point 19 metres south-east of that junction

2. Other restrictions – **bus stop clearway** – no stopping, except buses, at any time

SKEGBY ROAD, KIRKBY-IN-ASHFIELD (the north-east side)

3. Move bus stop AS0554 15 metres north-west of its current position and introduce a 19 metre long bus stop clearway
