

## <u>The Nottinghamshire County Council</u> (Little Oak Drive, Annesley) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2019 (4233)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Annesley in the District of Ashfield:-

Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along the following lengths of road: -

- <u>LITTLE OAK DRIVE, ANNESLEY (the north side)</u>
  The east-west leg from a point opposite a point 30 metres east of its junction with Willow Drive in a westerly direction for 88 metres
- <u>LITTLE OAK DRIVE, ANNESLEY</u> (the south side) The east-west leg from a point 20 metres west of its junction with Willow Drive in a westerly direction for 69 metres
