

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Mansfield Road and Pinfold Close, Skegby) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2019 (4231)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Skegby in the District of Ashfield:-

Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along the following lengths of roads: -

MANSFIELD ROAD, SKEGBY (the north-east side)

 from a point 15 metres north-west of its junction with Pinfold Close in a south-easterly direction to a point 14 metres south-east of that junction

PINFOLD CLOSE, SKEGBY (both sides)

• from its junction with Mansfield Road in a north-easterly direction for 15 metres
