

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Shepherds Lane and B6014 Wild Hill, Teversal) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2020 (4270)

The Council of the County of Nottinghamshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of road in Teversal in the District of Ashfield as specified in the Schedule of this Order.
- 2. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be revoked from the following Order "The Nottinghamshire County Council (B6014 Fackley Road, Wild Hill, Stanton Hill and Teversal) (30mph & 50mph Speed Limits) Restricted Road Order 2015 (4168)
- 3. This Order may be cited as "The Nottinghamshire County Council (B6014 Wild Hill, Teversal) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2020 (4270)" and shall come into force on the ## day of ## 2020.

SCHEDULE 1

Length of Roads at Teversal in the District of Ashfield

<u>Wild Hill</u>, <u>Teversel</u> - from a point 420 metres west of its junction with Shepherds Lane to a point 380 metres east of that junction.

<u>Shepherds Lane, Teversal</u> - from its junction with Wild Hill to a point 44 metres north of that junction.
