(WARSOP LANE, RAINWORTH) TRAFFIC CALMING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of powers conferred by Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 proposes to install "raised Traffic Calming Speed cushions" along Warsop Lane, Rainworth

The effects of which will be to: -

Install 3 No. sets of speed cushions on Warsop Ln, Rainworth; 1 cushion to the north and 2 to the south of the existing zebra crossing. These are 75mm high and 1.75m long in the direction of travel.

A plan showing the intended location of the road humps is attached and can be viewed at Nottinghamshire County Council's web site - consult.nottinghamshire.gov.uk

The proposed traffic calming features is intended to reduce the number of road accidents by slowing down the vehicles entering the residential area from the derestricted road.
