

**The Nottinghamshire County Council**  
**(Woodlands Way, Sutton-in-Ashfield)**  
**(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (4229)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Sutton-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield:-

Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting at any time** along the following lengths of road: -

1. WOODLANDS WAY, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD (both sides)

- from the perimeter of the roundabout at its junction with B6032 Alfreton Road in a south-easterly direction for 20 metres
