

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**The Nottinghamshire County (Forest Road and Park Avenue, Kirkby-in-Ashfield)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (4257)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads in Kirkby-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

FOREST ROAD (north side)

From a point 16 metres west of its junction with Park Avenue in an easterly direction to a point 17 metres east of that junction.

PARK AVENUE (both sides)

- From its junction with Forest Road in a north westerly direction for 16 metres.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall and libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
