

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Nottinghamshire County (Headland Avenue, Lawnwood Avenue and Lawnwood Lane, Elkesley) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (1262)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads in Elkesley in the District of Bassetlaw: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

HEADLAND AVENUE, ELKESLEY (the east side)

- From a point 9 metres north of the centre line of Lawnwood Avenue (East to West Section linking Headland Avenue to school) in a southerly direction to a point 17 metres south of the centre line of that junction.

HEADLAND AVENUE, ELKESLEY (the west side)

- From a point 2 metres south of a point opposite the centre line of Lawnwood avenue (West to East section linking Headland Avenue to school) in a southerly direction for 9 metres.

LAWNWOOD LANE, ELKESLEY (east side)

- From its junction with Lawnwood Avenue in a south westerly direction to a point opposite the boundary between Elkesley Stores and Briarstead.

LAWNWOOD AVENUE, ELKESLEY (North to South section) (west side)

- From its junction with Lawnwood Lane in a south easterly direction to a point 16 metres north west of the boundary of Number 86.

LAWNWOOD AVENUE (West to East section linking Headland Avenue to school), ELKESLEY (both sides)

- From its junction with Headland Avenue in an easterly direction for 10 metres
