

THE TWITCHELL AND LANGTON ROAD, SUTTON IN ASHFIELD
PROVISION OF TRAFFIC CALMING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980, proposes to install 75mm high raised plateaus across The Twitchell and Langton Road, Sutton in Ashfield.

The plateau will be at the following locations:-

The Twitchell

from its junction with High Pavement in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 14 metres.

Langton Road

from a point approximately 5 metres north-west of its junction with High Pavement in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 7 metres.

The raised plateaus are being installed to assist cyclists and pedestrians to cross the road at the junctions. The plateaus form part of the scheme to install a new cycle route along High Pavement from its junction with Station Road to its junction with Mill Street.

Any comments/objections (quoting ref: High Pavement) in respect of the traffic calming plateau proposals must be received by me, in writing or by e-mail, by **24th December 2021**.
