

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Town End Lane, Flintham) (30 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 2018) (8276)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Flintham in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

1. Town End Lane, Flintham

From a point 14 metres west of the eastern property boundary of Sunnyside in an easterly and south-easterly direction for a distance of 317 metres.

The 30mph speed limit is being introduced as an extension to the existing 30mph speed limit. The proposed new speed limit would start to the south-east of Hill Top Farm. The new speed limit would help to ensure that vehicles are driving at 30mph through the main part of the village. The lower speed limit will help make it safer for pedestrians and other vulnerable road users.
