

## BEACON HILL ROAD, NEWARK - PROPOSED TOUCAN CROSSING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a toucan crossing across Beacon Hill Road, Newark, between Cannon Close and Newbury Road, Newark on Trent in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

1. The proposals will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where **parking**, **stopping and loading will be prohibited**. The extents of the controlled area are: -

## **BEACON HILL ROAD, NEWARK ON TRENT**

(the north-west side)

• From a point 8 metres north-east of its junction with Cannon Close in a north-easterly direction for 35 metres

(the south-east side)

 From a point 17 metres north-east of its junction with Cannon Close in a north-easterly direction for 35 metres

The crossing is being installed to improve pedestrian facilities and reduce traffic speeds on approaches to the proposed crossing on Beacon Hill Road, Newark.

Any objections should clearly state the reasons for the objections and should reach us in writing, either by letter or email, by **4**<sup>th</sup> **September 2025**. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
