

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CAXTON CLOSE AND FORESTER STREET,
NETHERFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026 (7921)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Netherfield in the Borough of Gedling:-

1. Vehicles will be **prohibited from Waiting At Any Time** along the following length of road: -

CAXTON CLOSE, NETHERFIELD (both sides)

From its junction with Forester Street in a south-easterly direction for 10 metres

FORESTER STREET, NETHERFIELD (the south-east side)

From a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Caxton Close in a south-westerly direction to a point 10 metres south-west of that junction
