NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be on the following roads in Worksop in the District of Bassetlaw:-

1. to introduce **Limited Waiting Bays** on the following roads:-

EASTGATE - Extending from a point 84 metres east of a point opposite the centre line of George Street in an easterly direction to a point 76 metres east of a point opposite the centre line of Sherwood Road

1. to introduce **Residents Permit Parking** on the following roads:-

EASTGATE - Extending from a point 84 metres east of a point opposite the centre line of George Street in an easterly direction to a point 76 metres east of a point opposite the centre line of Sherwood Road
