

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Newcastle Avenue & Slack Lane, Worksop) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2017 (1208)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be on the following roads in Worksop in the District of Bassetlaw: -

1. to prohibit waiting at any time at the following locations.

Newcastle Avenue (South Side) - From a point 8 metres east of its junction with Devonshire Street in a westerly direction to a point 23 metres west of that junction

Slack Walk (East Side) - From its junction with Westgate in a southerly direction for 21 metres

Slack Walk (East Side) - From a point 9 metres north east of its junction with Garden Court in a south westerly direction to a point 6 metres south west of that junction

Slack Walk (East Side) - From a point 8 metres north east of its junction with Humphries Gardens in a south westerly direction to a point 21 metres south west of that junction with Humphries Gardens
