

## The Nottinghamshire County Council (Devonshire Street & Harrington Street, Worksop) (Residents' Controlled Zone) Traffic Regulation Order 2017 (1211)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be on the following roads in Worksop in the District of Bassetlaw: -

1. to introduce **Residents Permit Parking** on **Monday** to **Saturday 9am** to **3pm** on the following roads: -

<u>Devonshire Street (Both Sides)</u> - From a point 11 metres south of its junction with Newcastle Avenue for a distance of 162 metres

<u>Harrington Street (Both Sides)</u> - From its junction of Newcastle Avenue in a southerly direction to the southern extremity of adopted highway
