

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(A614 BAWTRY ROAD, BLYTH) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024 1273A**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Blyth in the District of Bassetlaw in the County of Nottinghamshire:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.
2. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.

**SCHEDULE**

**A614 BAWTRY ROAD, BLYTH**

- From a point 254m north its junction with The Woodlands in a north easterly direction to a point 529m south-west of its junction with Snape Lane (approximately 606m).
