

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(A614 BAWTRY ROAD, BLYTH) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2024 (1273A)

The Council of the County of Nottinghamshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act **Has Made** the following Order: -

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of road in Blyth in the District of Bassetlaw as specified in the Schedule of this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as "The Nottinghamshire County Council (A614 Bawtry Road, Blyth) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2024 (1273A)" and shall come into force on the **17th** day of **September 2024**.

From a point 254 metres north its junction with The Woodlands in a north easterly direction to a point 529 metres south-west of its junction with Snape Lane (approximately 606 metres).
