

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Chapel Lane, Everton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2023 (1279)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Everton in the District of Bassetlaw: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

Chapel Lane, Everton (the east side)

• From its junction with Bawtry Road (A631) in a northerly direction for 21 metres.

<u>Chapel Lane, Everton</u> (the west side)

• From its junction with Bawtry Road (A631) in a northerly direction for 18 metres.
