TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (1280)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Oldcotes in the District of Bassetlaw: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

Styrrup Road (B6463), Oldcotes
(the west side)

- From a point 93 metres north of the junction with Blyth Road (A634) in a northerly direction for a distance of 192 metres.

The proposals have been introduced to deal with inconsiderate and obstructive parking on Styrrup Road (B6463), Oldcotes. 'No Waiting At Any Time' restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) have been introduced at a width of 50mm and in colour Primrose Yellow.
