

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (MAIN STREET, SCAFTWORTH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (1283)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Scaftworth in the District of Bassetlaw: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting on Monday to Saturday between 7am – 7pm** along the following length of road: -

Main Street, Scaftworth (east side)

- From a point opposite a point 1 metre north of the southern building line of the King William Public House in a south-easterly direction for 30 metres.
- From From a point opposite a point 20 metres north of the southern building line of the King William Public House in a northerly direction for 48 metres.
- 2. Other Restrictions:- Bus Stop Clearway No Stopping on Monday to Saturday between 7am 7pm on the following length of road:

Main Street, Scaftworth (east side)

• From a point opposite a point 1 metre north of the southern building line of the King William Public House in a northerly direction for 19 metres.
