

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STATION AVENUE AND STATION ROAD, RANSKILL) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (1286)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Ranskill in the District of Bassetlaw:-

Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time along the following length of road: -

Station Avenue, Ranskill (both sides)

• From its junction with Station Road in a northerly direction for 12 metres.

Station Road, Ranskill (north side)

• From a point 10 metres west of its junction with Station Avenue in an easterly direction to a point 15 metres east of that junction.

Station Road, Ranskill (south side)

• From a point opposite a point 8 metres east of the eastern kerbline of Station Avenue in a westerly direction for 22 metres.
