

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LIME TREE AVENUE AND ROADS OFF THE A614 BLYTH ROAD, BABWORTH AND ELKESLEY) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (1287)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Babworth and Elkesley in the District of Bassetlaw: -

Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time along the following length of road: -

Access Road to Cabin Hill Covert, Elkesley (both sides)

• From its junction with A614 Blyth Road in a westerly direction for 16 metres (as measured along its centre line).

Entrance to the parking area opposite Lime Tree Avenue, Babworth and Elkesley (both sides)

• From its junction with A614 Blyth Road in a north-easterly direction for 10 metres (as measured along its centre line).

Lime Tree Avenue, Elkesley (both sides)

• From its junction with A614 Blyth Road in a south-westerly direction for 56 metres (as measured along its centre line).
