

<u>THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL</u> (GRAFTON STREET, WORKSOP)(RESIDENTS' PARKING ZONE) <u>TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (1293)</u>

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Worksop in the District of Bassetlaw: -

1. <u>Residents' Parking Scheme on Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6pm along the following length of road: -</u>

(i) **<u>GRAFTON STREET</u>** From its junction with Gateford Road in a south-westerly direction for 124 metres.

- 2. Lengths of road where a **permit** will be required to park on **Mon to Sat between 8am and 6pm**
- (i) **<u>GRAFTON STREET Both sides</u>**

From its junction with Gateford Road in a south-westerly direction for 124 metres.

The restrictions remove non-resident parking from outside the terraced houses on Grafton Street. The existing single yellow lines (no waiting on all days between 8am and 6pm) at the junction with Gateford Road are unchanged by the proposed Residents' Parking Scheme.
