

## THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (MAIN GATE DRIVE, HARWORTH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (1296)

<u>NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN</u> that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Harworth in the District of Bassetlaw: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following: -

## MAIN GATE DRIVE, HARWORTH

(the north-west side)

- From its junction with Scrooby Road in a south-westerly direction for 113 metres (the south-east side)
  - From its junction with Scrooby Road in a south-westerly direction for 130 metres

## **ACCESS ROAD**

(the north side)

- From its junction with Main Gate Drive in an easterly direction for 20 metres (the south side)
  - From its junction with Main Gate Drive in an easterly direction for 17 metres
