

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (INGS LANE AND MAIN STREET, WEST STOCKWITH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (1300)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at West Stockwith in the District of Bassetlaw: -

1. **Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

INGS LANE, WEST STOCKWITH (the north-east side)

- From its junction with Main Street in a north-westerly direction for 13 metres.

INGS LANE, WEST STOCKWITH (the south-west side)

- From its junction with Main Street in a north-westerly direction for 15 metres.

MAIN STREET, WEST STOCKWITH (the north-west side)

- From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Ings Lane in a north-easterly direction to a point 10 metres north-east of that junction.
