

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A638 GREAT NORTH ROAD, BARNBY MOOR) (30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) AND (RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER 2025 (1315)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Barnby Moor in the Bassetlaw District in the County of Nottinghamshire.

- 1. The length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order shall be a Restricted Road (30mph) for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- 2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on that length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

A638 GREAT NORTH ROAD, BARNBY MOOR

• From a point 30 metres south-east of its junction with Station Road in a north-westerly direction to a point 35 metres north of its junction with Retford Road (approximately 912 metres).

SCHEDULE 2

A638 GREAT NORTH ROAD, BARNBY MOOR

From a point 35 metres north of its junction with Retford Road in a northerly direction for 229 metres.
