

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BLYTH ROAD, HARWORTH) (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025 (1317)

The Council of the County of Nottinghamshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 81, 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.
- 2. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any enactment replace by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order is hereby revoked.
- 3. This Order may be cited as "THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BLYTH ROAD, HARWORTH) (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025 (1317)" and shall come into force on the 29th August 2025.

SCHEDULE

BLYTH ROAD, HARWORTH

• From a point 130 metres north-west of its junction with Symmetry Way in a north-westerly direction to a point 449 metres south-east of its junction with Serlby Road. (an approximate distance of 1458m)
