

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BLYTH ROAD, HARWORTH) (40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025 (1317)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Harworth in the District of Bassetlaw in the County of Nottinghamshire.

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

• From a point 130 metres north-west of its junction with Symmetry Way in a north-westerly direction to a point 449 metres south-east of its junction with Serlby Road. (an approximate distance of 1458m)
