(BRACKEN LANE, RETFORD) (PROPOSED 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025 (1319)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Retford in the District of Bassetlaw in the County of Nottinghamshire:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.

SCHEDULE

BRACKEN LANE, RETFORD

- From a point 41 metres east of the western boundary line of Property No. 50 in an easterly then northerly direction to its junction with Grove Road. (an approximate distance of 947 metres).
