

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STATION ROAD, SOUTH LEVERTON)
(PROPOSED 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025 (1325)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at South Leverton in the District of Bassetlaw in the County of Nottinghamshire: -

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.

SCHEDULE

STATION ROAD, SOUTH LEVERTON

- From a point 50 metres south of the centerline of the level crossing in a southerly direction for 400 metres.
