



THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BRINSLEY WAY, BIRCOTES)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING, BUS STOP CLEARWAYS AND PROVISION OF TRAFFIC CALMING)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026 (1339)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 (traffic calming hump), the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No 1086 as amended, proposes to install No Waiting At Any Time and Bus Stop Clearways restrictions and a series of raised traffic calming plateaus, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Bircotes in the Bassetlaw District:-

1. Proposed **prohibition of Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -
BLYTH ROAD, BIRCOTES (east-side)
 - From its junction with Brinsley Road in a north-westerly direction for 26 metres.**BRINSLEY WAY, BIRCOTES** (north-side)
 - From its junction with Blyth Road in a north-easterly and then an easterly direction for 762 metres.**BRINSLEY WAY, BIRCOTES** (south-side)
 - From its junction with Blyth Road in north-easterly and then an easterly direction for 765 metres.
2. The extents of the plateaus are detailed below:
 - Six 75mm high raised plateaus from its junction with Blyth Road in a north-easterly then easterly direction for 775 metres.
3. Other restrictions: - **Bus Stop Clearway** – No Stopping At Any Time, except Buses
BRINSLEY WAY, BIRCOTES (north-side)
 - From a point 214 metres north-easterly and then easterly direction of its junction with Blyth Road in an easterly direction for 19 metres.
 - From a point 616 metres north-easterly and then easterly direction of its junction with Blyth Road in an easterly direction for 19 metres.**BRINSLEY WAY, BIRCOTES** (south-side)
 - From a point 243 metres north-easterly and then easterly direction of its junction with Blyth Road in an easterly direction for 19 metres.
 - From a point 597 metres north-easterly and then easterly direction of its junction with Blyth Road in an easterly direction for 19 metres.
