

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SOUTH STREET AND THRUMPTON LANE, RETFORD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026 (1343)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Retford in the Bassetlaw District:-

1. Proposed **prohibition of Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

MEDEN WAY, RETFORD (the north-west side)

- From its junction with Thrumpton Lane in south-westerly direction for 10 metres.

MEDEN WAY, RETFORD (the south-east side)

- From its junction with Thrumpton Lane in south-westerly direction for 10 metres.

SOUTH STREET, RETFORD (the south-west side)

- From its junction with Beehive Street in a south-easterly and then an easterly direction for 27 metres.

THRUMPTON LANE, RETFORD (the north-east side)

- From a point 12 metres north-west of its junction with Whinney Moor Way in a south-easterly direction to a point 10 metres south-east of that junction.

THRUMPTON LANE, RETFORD (the south-west side)

- From a point 11 metres north-west of its junction with Meden Way in a south-easterly direction to a point 10 metres south-east of that junction.

WHINNEY MOOR WAY, RETFORD (the north-west side)

- From its junction with Thrumpton Lane in a north-easterly direction for 12 metres.

WHINNEY MOOR WAY, RETFORD (the south-east side)

- From its junction with Thrumpton Lane in a north-easterly direction for 17 metres.
