

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (St Catherine Street and St Margaret Street, Mansfield) (Prohibition of Waiting and Residents' Controlled Zone) Traffic Regulation Order 2017 (2208)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Mansfield in the District of Mansfield:-

1. **New Residents Parking Area on the following roads**
  - (i) **ST CATHERINE STREET (MANSFIELD)**  
from a point 3 metres north-east of its junction with St Margaret Street in a south-westerly direction to its south-western extremity.
  - (ii) **ST MARGARET STREET (MANSFIELD)**  
from a point 10 metres south-east of its junction with Baum's Lane in a south-easterly direction to its junction with St Catherine Street.
2. **Prohibition of waiting at any time at the following locations,**
  - (i) **ST CATHERINE STREET (MANSFIELD) - (the north-west side)**  
from a point 3 metres north-east of its junction with St Margaret Street in a south-westerly direction to a point 5 metres south-west of the same junction.
  - (ii) **ST MARGARET STREET (MANSFIELD) - (both sides)**  
from its junction with St Catherine Street in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 5 metres.

The proposed double yellow lines are intended to improve visibility for drivers and pedestrians at the junction between St Catherine Street and St Margaret Street. The residents parking area is intended to remove non-resident parking to leave more space for residents to park.
