

<u>THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL</u> (BERRY HILL LANE AND SANDHURST AVENUE, MANSFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025 (2281)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Mansfield in the District of Mansfield: -

1. Proposed prohibition of Waiting At Any Time along the following length of road: -

Berry Hill Lane, Mansfield (north-side)

• From its junction with Sandhurst Avenue in a westerly direction for 10 metres.

- Berry Hill Lane, Mansfield (north-east side)
- From its junction with Sandhurst Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 3 metres. **Sandhurst Avenue, Mansfield** (north-east side)

• From its junction with Berry Hill Lane in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres. **Sandhurst Avenue, Mansfield** (south-west side)

• From its junction with Berry Hill Lane in a north-westerly direction for 11 metres.

2. Other restrictions: - **Bus Stop Clearway** – No Stopping At Any Time, except Buses **Berry Hill Lane, Mansfield** (north-east side)

• From a point 3 metres south-east of its junction with Sandhurst Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 19 metres.
