**BERRY HILL LANE AND SANDHURST AVENUE, MANSFIELD 'NO WAITING'
RESTRICTIONS - DOUBLE YELLOW LINES AND BUS STOP CLEARWAY (TRO 2281)
- STAGE TWO**

Via East Midlands Ltd is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver Highway Services.

Nottinghamshire County Council has received complaints of obstructive and inconsiderate parking at the junction of Sandhurst Avenue and Berry Hill Lane, Mansfield. To help alleviate the problems it is proposed to introduce double yellow lines ('No Waiting at Any Time') restrictions.

It is also proposed to introduce a new 19 metre Bus Stop Clearway to be in operation 24 hours.

The County Council works closely with all public transport operators across the County to identify bus stops that suffer from inconsiderate parking. At the location above, a bus stop clearway is proposed that prohibits other vehicles from parking or waiting at any time at this bus stop, this will be clearly identified with new road markings and signage. The main benefits of bus stop clearways are to:

- Help the bus align with the kerb to enable better access for disabled passengers and pushchair users;
- Ease congestion as a correctly aligned bus will not block the road for other road users;
- Ensure that bus drivers discharge their duty to drop passengers off on the kerb and not on the road;
- Ensure that bus services operate on time and are not unnecessarily delayed.

Further to the initial consultation letter of 17th February 2025, the next stage of the consultation is to publicly advertise the scheme. The notice will be published in the Mansfield and Ashfield Chad and notices will be fixed on site. A plan showing the proposals is attached (Drawing Number H/CLW/4937/01) along with a copy of the site notice.
