

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (REGENT STREET, MANSFIELD
(NO LOADING RESTRICTIONS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026 (2288)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Mansfield in the District of Mansfield: -

1. Vehicles will be **Prohibited from Loading At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

REGENT STREET, MANSFIELD

(the north-west side)

- From a point 3 metres south-west of its junction with Alfred Court in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Clumber Street

REGENT STREET, MANSFIELD

(the south-east side)

- From its junction with Clumber Street in a south-westerly direction to a point 3 metres south-west of its junction with Alfred Court including its south-western extremity
