PUBLIC CONSULTATION - BRIAR ROAD AND CHURCH CIRCLE, NEW
OLLERTON, PROPOSED INTRODUCTION OF PARKING RESTRICTIONS AND
BUS STOP CLEARWAYS – TRO 3274

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Ollerton in the Borough of Newark and Sherwood:-

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along :-

- Briar Road - (the west side)

From its junction with Church Circle in a southerly direction for 12 meters.

- Church Circle– (the outer perimeter)

From its junction with Briar Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 11 meters.

- Church Circle– (the inner perimeter)

From a point opposite the eastern kerb-line of Briar Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 45 meters.
