



**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BECKINGHAM ROAD, CODDINGTON) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2026 (3304)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Coddington in the District of Newark and Sherwood in the County of Nottinghamshire.

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.

SCHEDULE

BECKINGHAM ROAD, CODDINGTON

- From its junction with Beacon Hill Road and Newbury Road in a north-westerly direction to a point 71 metres north-east of its junction with the A1 Slip Road.
- 2. The following Order is hereby revoked in so far as it relates to the length of road specified in the Schedule of the Order.

3. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replace by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order are hereby revoked.
