(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2022 (3343)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Rainworth in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

Nightjar Way, Rainworth (both sides)

- From its junction with Warsop Lane in a south – easterly direction for 10 metres.

B6020 Warsop Lane, Rainworth (the east side)

- From a point 10 metres south of its junction with Nightjar Way in a northerly direction to a point 10 metres north of that junction.
