

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (EPPERSTONE ROAD AND THE LEYS, LOWDHAM) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (3356)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council Has Made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Lowdham in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

Epperstone Road, Lowdham (the south-west side)

• From a point 15 metres north-west of its junction with The Leys in a south-easterly direction to a point 12 metres south-east of that junction.

The Leys, Lowdham (the north-west side)

• From its junction with Epperstone Road in a south-westerly direction for 15 metres.

The Leys, Lowdham (the south-east side)

• From its junction with Epperstone Road in a south-westerly direction for 15 metres.
